When Operation Finally Home officials handed U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Danny Joe Billek the keys to his new home last year, he knew that he and his family were receiving a beautiful gift. But after a year in his new home, Billek says he recognizes the gift for what it is: a blessing.

"It has been a little over a year since we moved into our forever home, and each day brings such joy and happiness," Danny said. "We have been able to focus on our family and grow closer to God since we moved in—through family dinners in our dining room, watching lots of Marvel movies in the living room, and enjoying many sunny days together in the backyard."

Operation Finally Home exists to provide mortgage-free homes, home modifications and transitional housing to America's heroes: military veterans, first responders and their families. Since 2005, Operation Finally Home has completed or is in the planning stages of more than 430 home projects across 32 states.

Danny served his country for nearly 14 years, including four combat deployments: three to Iraq and one to Afghanistan. A right-knee injury during his final deployment ended his combat readiness, sending him and his family, which includes his wife Kimberly and four children, to Ft. Sill, Oklahoma. In 2016, Danny was medically discharged.

Enjoying their new home in Bartow, Florida, Danny says the gift has helped his family to find "a healthy balance" in their lives. Danny and Kimberly's oldest son is now enrolled in college and "making excellent progress toward his degree," while the younger children are participating in wrestling and Tae Kwon Do in addition to their studies.

"I pray for all the families that have been blessed by this organization because this has been a blessing for our family," Danny said. "Thank you so much for wearing the light of God for our nation's warriors."

It's a feeling U.S. Marine Corporal Ray Lopez understands well. Lopez, who served for more than four years, including three tours of Iraq, moved into his home in Odessa, Texas, last January.

"The words I have about this blessed and amazing home are excitement, relief and joy," Ray said. "We are closer as a family because of this gift and the best is how much my girls just love to be at home relaxing with Daddy!"

Lopez says his mortgage-free home has relieved his stress level and allowed him and his daughters to truly enjoy their new home—and each other—more.

"I am excited about this home each and every day," he said. "It has relieved so many of the stressors that were an issue before. We are so blessed and very thankful for everything Operation Finally Home and Silver Leaf has done for us and continue to do for so many deserving people."






THANK YOU, PHIL!
